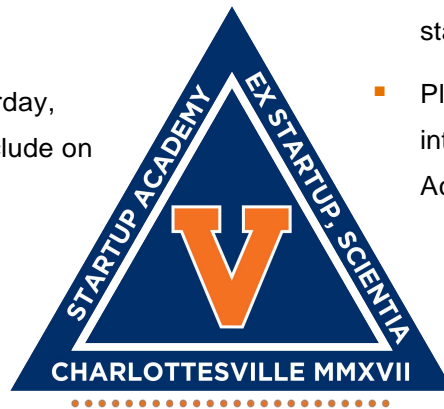
The Program
