Welcome to Recruiting at UVA Darden

Dear Recruiting Partner,

We are thrilled that you are seeking UVA Darden MBA talent in the upcoming 2026-27 recruiting season.

This recruiting packet is intended to provide you with useful information on the recruiting events available, the recruiting timeline, and guidelines that ensure mutually beneficial outcomes.

In partnership with you, we seek to provide students and employers with a level playing field and a fair and equitable recruiting process that allows our students time for evaluating opportunities, and our employers equal and timely access to all of our talented MBA students.

These guidelines apply to any company that utilizes Darden's recruiting platform [Darden Career Link \[DCL\]](#), Career Center services, or partners with a student club to promote, market, or showcase their job opportunities to students through events or interviews — whether held on Darden Grounds or virtually.

Darden's MBA degree is offered in three formats — all of which confer the same prestigious degree, a Master of Business Administration from the University of Virginia. In addition to Darden's renowned Full-Time, residential MBA program, we also have world-class Executive MBA (EMBA) and Part-Time MBA (PTMBA) program formats. Recruiting with Darden, you will also gain access to students pursuing an M.S. in Business Analytics and all UVA Darden alumni.

We appreciate your commitment to hiring talent at Darden and willingness to partner with the School's faculty student and Career Center.

Our event reservation request window will open in Darden Career Link (DCL), our recruiting management platform, on **Wednesday, 20 May at 12:00 pm EDT**. Starting in this recruiting season, Darden Career Link will be powered by 12twenty. We look forward to sharing additional information and resources related to this transition before the reservation request window opens.

- Reservation requests will be evaluated starting **Wednesday, 3 June at 8:00 am EDT**. Reservation requests received after that time will be evaluated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Event and interview confirmations will be sent in June.
- When submitting interview and event requests, we **require** that you have a 1st, 2nd and 3rd choice, as event dates are not guaranteed. Please ensure your three choices are dates across multiple weeks throughout the recruiting timeline.

Event and Interview Options

Company Briefing (Virtual or In-person)

A **40-minute, large format event** that often consists of 20 minutes of presentation and 20 minutes Q&A. Breakout sessions are recommended if the event is virtual; however, this is merely a framework. You have flexibility to use the event time as you wish and be creative. In-person events can be coordinated in Charlottesville and/or in Arlington at UVA Darden DC Metro, Sands Family Grounds.

Office Hours (Virtual or In-person)

Also referred to as “Coffee Chats”, these are 15-, 20-, or 30-minute informal, small-scale sessions for two or three students. Students register in advance and the sign-up list is available to you in advance.

Receptions (In-person)

If you intend to **host receptions on- or off-Grounds**, please do so between **6 p.m. and 10 p.m.** We are happy to provide you with recommended venue information to assist with early stages of planning.

Part-Time MBA Dinner & Company Conversations

Connect with Part-Time MBA (PTMBA) students through evening engagements hosted at Darden's DC Metro location, Sands Family Grounds, which is home to [180 PTMBA students](#). These events provide **a dedicated, in-person setting for employers to build relationships with PTMBA students** in a welcoming and conversational environment. Employers may host a session or program in conjunction with a PTMBA dinner, designing the evening to align with their recruiting objectives. Formats may include a company overview, panel Q/A, facilitated discussion, or casual networking. This flexible structure allows organizations to showcase their culture, share insights, and engage directly with PTMBA talent. The cost of dinner will not be incurred by the company.

Darden DC Connections

Darden DC Connections is a **networking reception held at UVA Darden DC Metro** offering employers the opportunity to meet with our students in our convenient Rosslyn, VA location. Primarily targeted at Executive MBA and Part-Time MBA students, this evening event is also open to students from the Full-Time MBA program who choose to travel from Charlottesville. The event will be held on Friday, 18 September 2026.

Career Symposium: Recruiting Spotlight & Alumni Networking Reception

New The Darden Career Symposium is a two-day immersive recruiting event dedicated to student-employer engagement and career exploration. Held on **Wednesday 21 October – Thursday 22 October 2026**, students and employers will convene for a range of activities including company briefings, coffee chats, and interviews for full-time opportunities. The event includes a networking reception on Wednesday evening.

We encourage employers across industries and organization sizes to take advantage of this dedicated recruiting window to build relationships and engage with Darden talent. The timing is **especially advantageous for organizations hiring into corporate, rotational and general management roles**, offering a more focused environment for meaningful engagement with students. Participation is free of charge.

Full-Day Event in Partnership with the Batten Institute

In partnership with the Batten Institute of Innovation, Darden will host a full day of programming centered on careers in technology and industry innovation on **Friday 23 October 2026**. This event is designed to **bring together employers and students interested in technology-focused roles** including both technology companies and tech-related functions within broader organizations. Student Club Events

Employers may choose to partner directly with a student organization to host a targeted recruiting event. To ensure strong attendance and minimize scheduling conflicts, **employers should first coordinate with the Recruiting Operations team before confirming event details**. The Recruiting Operations team can then facilitate introductions to the appropriate student clubs.

When planning events outside of standard Darden recruiting offerings (e.g., club partnerships, second-year ambassador programs, or office-specific receptions and networking events), coordination with the Recruiting Operations team is required to ensure alignment with the broader recruiting calendar and student commitments.



First Round Interviews (Virtual or In-person)

We recommend that you use the Darden Career Link (DCL) system to schedule interviews for a dedicated Darden interview day. Students will automatically be placed in interview slots based on their availability. See the associated Interview Due Date Calendars on the following pages.

Interview Alternates

It is best to provide multiple, ranked alternate invitations for each interview schedule. If your pre-selected candidates do not accept your invitation, their slots will be filled by your selected alternates. **We strongly encourage a robust list of alternate candidates.**

Second Round Interviews

Organizations hosting second rounds (at Darden, off-site, or virtually) are responsible for conducting their own scheduling and logistics beyond the first round. All companies must provide at least one alternate second round date for students. **Second round interviews cannot conflict with classes** due to the rigorous academic standards upheld at Darden.

Resume Books

The Darden Career Center provides employers with access to resume books at no cost where employers are able to search, view and download curated resumes.

Recruiting Policies

Academic Commitments

The academic calendar is the main driver of recruiting dates and availability.

- **Darden students may not miss class or academic commitments for any recruiting-related activities.** For planning purposes, view schedule restrictions below and in the calendars.
- Employers cannot require a student, as a condition of employment candidacy, to interview at a time that conflicts with that student's academic schedule.
- First Year students are expected to meet with their Learning Teams Sunday through Wednesday afternoons. Participation in Learning Teams is an academic commitment that is critical to student success in Darden's Case Method learning environment.

Schedule Restrictions

Event dates are not guaranteed and will be scheduled on a first-come, first-serve basis. It is our goal to maximize student attendance. We will focus on coordinating across industries, functions, and target audiences. Event timing is highly constrained and cannot be customized within the event request process.

Employers should plan within the approved windows below, as events outside of these times will not be confirmed or promoted.

- **Targeting First Year, internship-seeking MBA students?** Students have core classes Monday-Thursday from 8:00 a.m. – 1:10 p.m. and Academic Learning Teams Sunday-Wednesday from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Recruiting events may only take place outside of these times.
- **Targeting full-time seeking students?** Briefings can be scheduled between 1:30 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. Late afternoon (4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.) is the most effective window for engaging a broader audience, including EMBA and PTMBA students.

Recruiting Activities

Minimal event conflict is in the best interest of students and employers. **If an employer is working directly with a student club, it is best practice to proactively contact the Recruiting Operations team with any questions,** and/or to gain holistic insights on the recruiting calendar/scheduling.

Employers are not approved to host company events during August pre-matriculation, final exams, or on other specific dates. View key dates on the following pages.

Employer Interviews

Interviews for full-time hiring begin on 22 September 2026. Interviews for internship hiring begin on 4 January 2027. Your Recruiting Operations partner will work with you to determine a date that is most appropriate for your on-Grounds or virtual interviews. We highly encourage you to identify a minimum of two (2) alternate candidates for every 10 invited candidates.

Recruiters should give students sufficient notice (and maintain flexibility where possible) for second round interviews or other events held out of town. Students may have other obligations, including other interviews, which cannot be rescheduled on short notice without penalty to the student.

Severe Inclement Weather

As soon as we know the school is closed, or on a modified schedule, the Recruiting Operations team will reach out and work with our recruiting partners to make alternate arrangements, which may include rescheduling, switching to a virtual format, or remaining as scheduled.

Early Recruiting

Darden recognizes that some companies participate in fellowship programs that involve early opportunities for internship interviews and offers. We support these early opportunities subject to the following conditions:

- Candidates are given at least ten business days to consider such offers. Best practice is to **keep offers open until 5 February 2027** to give students time to make an informed decision.


Hiring International MBA Students

International MBA students make up more than a third of the Full-Time MBA student population and represent some of the best and brightest management talent from around the world.

International students on F-1 status are authorized to work in the U.S. for summer internships by using Curricular Practical Training (CPT) and for one year of full-time employment after graduation by using Optional Practical Training (OPT). The Darden MBA is an accredited STEM-certified degree meaning that students may work for up to three years in the U.S., provided the position for which they are hired relates to their STEM degree.

If you have not done so in the past, we urge you to get to know our talented pool of international students and consider them for employment within your organization for both U.S. and overseas opportunities. You can connect with them through internationally focused student clubs, on-Grounds events, and other activities.

NOTE: When recruiting at Darden or creating a job posting, providing information on work authorization requirements ensures students understand any constraints placed on positions.

Investment Banking Policies and Guidelines

Firms recruiting for investment banking should refer to the Investment Banking Recruiting Policies and Guidelines.

Offer Guidelines

Darden's offer guidelines and deadlines aim to meet the needs of both recruiters and students and benefit all parties.

All students must receive an offer in WRITING. The beginning of the offer period will coincide with the date of the written offer.

Full-Time (Post-MBA) Offers

If the full-time offer is extended as the result of a summer internship:

The job offer must remain open until **6 November 2026**, or three weeks from the date the written offer is received, whichever is later.

If the full-time offer is extended before 1 January 2027:

The job offer must remain open until **6 November 2026**, or three weeks from the date the written offer is received, whichever is later.

If the full-time offer is extended after 1 January 2027:

The job offer must remain open for a **minimum of two weeks** from the date the written offer is received.

Internship Offers

Regardless of format (virtual or in-person) and location (at Darden or company offices), no initial employer interviews or internship offers should occur prior to **4 January 2027**.

The internship offer must remain open until **5 February 2027**, or three weeks from the date the written offer is received, whichever is later.

If an internship offer is extended on 1 March 2027 or later:

The internship offer must remain open for a **minimum of two weeks** from the date the written offer is received.

Due to academic commitments, internships must begin no earlier than 10 May and must end by 13 August 2027.

Exploding Offers and Withdrawing Offers

Employers are not to apply undue pressure or unreasonable expectations related to accepting offers. Examples include exploding offers, requiring verbal accepts, and changes to offer terms.
